In this final phase, we are focused on evaluating the impact of these practices and gathering valuable feedback from teachers, coaches, and participants.

Each partner is collecting assessments, completing questionnaires, and organizing focus groups. Experts, including coaches and sport teachers, will share their insights, helping us refine the tools and resources developed throughout the project to ensure they meet the diverse needs of communities across Europe.

Stay tuned as we prepare to share the results and insights from this transformative project, which is paving the way for a more inclusive future through sport.

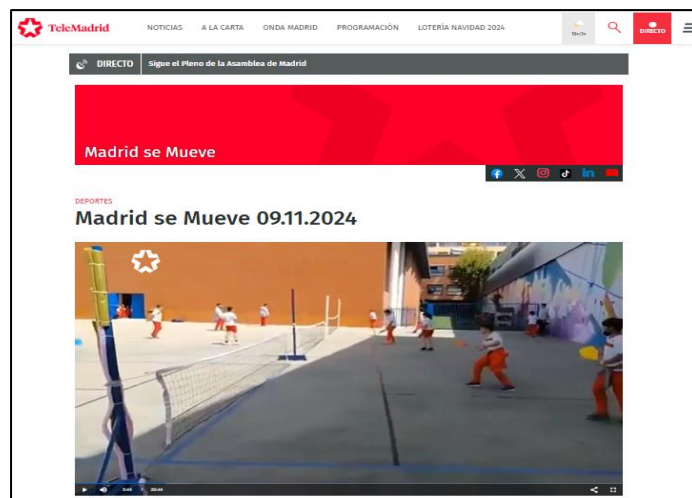
IDI4SPORT in the Spanish public television
